Launch out into the deep by Phillip Briggs

In Luke 5:4-6, we read about a fishing story with Jesus and Peter, which we can learn from: "When He [Jesus] had finished speaking, He said to Simon [Peter], 'Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a catch.' Simon answered and said, 'Master, we worked hard all night and caught nothing, but at your word, I will let down the nets.' When they had done this, they enclosed a great quantity of fish, and their nets began to break..."

There are 3 lessons that we learned from this:

1. Trying hard doesn't necessarily get the job done: Peter and his colleagues had "worked hard all night," so no one can doubt their efforts. They simply were too shallow, and all the efforts in the world wouldn't have gotten them the catch they were hoping for. Like Peter and his partners, the White Chocolate ministry team had toiled several weekends a year just trying to catch the one. We became discouraged. In May 08, while in Dallas with Larry Locker on his Memorial Weekend outreach, something was different. As Larry prayed for us, he said that we were to launch out and begin doing outreaches in our own backyard. I remember on the way home that night, we all had come to the same conclusion... it was time. In July 08, God gave us our first catch with a man named James Hall. One month later, we picked up our next 3 men. Before we knew it, Tim and Misty had 5 men sleeping on their living room floor. By Sept, we rented our first house and grew to 14 guys. Later we rented our 2nd home and grew to 21 men.

2. The deeper life is the key to abundant life: Two years ago, we were all employed and doing financially well. We lacked nothing... So we thought... During our 1st year, God would use Tim's income to support HOD. Little did anyone of us know, that God was going to require

'Greater Faith' from us. This type of Faith was that which would move mountains and withstand storms. Remember the parable of the wise and foolish builders? Both built a house, but when the storms came, only the wise man's house was still standing. Why? Because, as Jesus said, he "dug deep and laid his foundation upon the rock."

3. Doing things God's way, no matter how uncomfortable or unusual, will result in the greatest blessings: Peter was a professional fisherman, yet his willingness to "let down the net" (his pride) was what allowed him to obtain a great catch. What has been the key to our success is our willingness to humble ourselves and surrender to God's will in each of our lives. To give up what we know and to trust in God. We have stepped into HOD full time. We left the comfort of financial security and stepped into depending on God to meet our needs. Today, not only does God meet our needs, but He meets the needs of 21 men and the staff. Also, thru this ministry, we help provide food to other ministries in Longview. In Feb 09, God opened the door for us to obtain a 12,000 sq ft funeral home in downtown Longview. This funeral home, which was once a place the dead were brought to be put to rest, has now become a place for the dead to come alive in Christ. We offer a structured discipleship program for men who are ready for change. During this time they develop a relationship with Christ, through daily devotions and classes. The Word of God being daily imparted into the lives of our men is the key to their deliverance. Since Oct 08, we have maintained 16-22 men at any given time. Like Peter, we are asking for your help. Not necessarily financially, but with your prayers. It is the prayers of God's people that help us the most.
