It's not because you don't want to help. It's because you don't know how to help. As you are sitting there, you debate on what to do. Should you look at your phone as though you are busy? Should you just keep looking straight ahead to ignore the situation? Would handing them \$5 really help the person climb out of the pit of poverty? Or will it just aid and enable them to purchase their next high? Colossians 4:5 teaches us to "walk in wisdom" toward individuals who are in need. Sometimes helping can hurt, if the help is not a long-term commitment to pull the person out of their mess.

## "My Story" by Brice Blanchard

My name is Brice Blanchard. I was born in Denton, Texas, in 1985. My dad died in 1988 and my mother remarried a navy seal. He was very abusive to me and my mother. One of my earliest memories was my stepdad knocking me out and breaking my collarbone while I was trying to protect my mother. Soon after that, my mother took me and my brothers and moved out. Pain followed us wherever we went and soon my

mom began using drugs. I started using drugs in the 5th grade as a way to escape from stress. Before long I was introduced to meth. It consumed my life and as a result, my girlfriend threatened to leave me. I told her that I would stop, but I could not. That night I tried to hurt myself, but the paramedics were able to revive me even though I stopped breathing for 15 minutes. I had suffered a heart attack and a stoke. The doctors thought I would never speak again, but by the grace of God, I woke up and started speaking. I only spent 2 days in the ICU. My grandmother prayed for a whole month that God would heal me and the next time I went to see the cardiologist the



3D scan of my heart revealed God's answer to my grandmother's prayers. My heart was functioning at 100 %. My stepfather died soon after that and I went back to the one thing that I knew. My meth use soon pushed my girlfriend and daughter out of my life. Eventually, I was arrested and spent 9 months in jail. When I got out, I once again went back to meth and was in and out of jail and homeless shelters. After

some time, I was arrested in Denison for possession of meth. I pleaded with God for a chance to change. Once again God's grace was shown to me and I only spent 5 days in jail. When I was released, I went to rehab in Dallas. After I got out, I continued to pursue God and found the House of Disciples. At HOD, I was able to start renewing my mind. I began to see me the way God sees me. Through Jesus Christ, the redeemer of my soul, I was blessed with a chance to change and live again. I am so thankful to God and the House of Disciples.
